

SAFETY RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR CARTAGE CONTRACTORS



The following safety rules and guidelines have been revised for all cartage contractors entering Brookby Quarry, to ensure compliance with our Health and Safety requirements and resource consent conditions. Failure to follow these rules may result in you being denied entry into Brookby Quarry. All incidents, accidents, near-misses or hazards must be reported immediately to any Kaipara personnel or to the weighbridge. You are not permitted to leave the site after an incident without the Quarry Operations Manager or Technical Managers approval. Please report hazards or unsafe driving to the weighbridge.

- 2. Loading of trucks is not permitted prior to 7:00am, Monday to Saturday.

50	Restrict your speed to 50 km/h on Kimptons Road. Truck speeds are monitored and recorded. Any truck exceeding the 50 km/h speed limit guideline could result in being denied access to Brookby Quarry.	GIVE	All vehicles approaching the quarry must give way at the one lane bridge on Kimptons Road.	
NO STOPPING	Please refrain from stopping or parking on Twilight Road. Strictly no stopping, parking or overtaking of light vehicles or road trucks on Kimptons Road.		Please exercise extreme caution when approaching or passing pedestrians or cyclists and while passing the sweeper truck working on the road.	
RESIDENTIAL AREA DO NOT USE ENGINE BRAKES	Please no engine brakes.	SCHOOL ZONE	All vehicles entering the Brookby School Zone should not exceed 40 km/h when signs are visible and yellow lights are flashing.	
	OPERATING WITHIN	I BROOKBY QUARE	RY	
New Zealand road rules apply within Brookby Quarry. Observe and abide by all road signs within the quarry. Observe and abide by the speed limits as per the designated speed signs.				
	If fitted, turn on your flashing beacon while in the quarry.			
CB 11	Use channel 11 to communicate with our loader drivers and the weighbridge.			
③	No use of mobile phones while in the quarry.			
•	Use caution when interacting with heavy machinery. Do not overtake any vehicles in the quarry.			
STAY IN TRUCK AT ALL TIMES	Due to the amount of heavy traffic interaction in the quarry, road truck drivers must stay in their cabs at all times for their own safety (unless it is an emergency).

DESIGNATED PULL OVER AREAS	 Only use our designated pull over areas to check your covers, tailgates and drawbars etc: On entry to the quarry there is a pull over area to your left inside the quarry gate. In the operational area there is a pull over area before top office when exiting the pit areas. When exiting the quarry via the weighbridge there is a pull over area to your left. 				
THIS PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT MUST BE WORN IN THIS AREA	Minimum PPE requirement when out of truck to check loads is: Hard hat High-visibility vest Safety glasses Steel capped footwear				
NO Littering	No littering in the quarry.				
NO WASHOUT	No wash out facility. Rinse out only in daylight hours, please ask the weighbridge.				
NO ABUSE	Abuse towards load operators and quarry personnel could result in permanent dismissal from site without question. If you have any concerns on quarry activities, please speak with the weighbridge staff who will contact the Quarry Operations Manager.				
EXITING BROOKBY QUARRY					
TRUCK WASH	All trucks exiting the quarry via the weighbridge shall go through the overhead truck wash facility.				
COVERS	Leave covers off when arriving on the weighbridge so load can be inspected.				
All vehicles exiting the quarry to Kimptons Road shall slow down vapproaching the Give Way sign and be prepared to stop. Give Wattraffic from your left and right directions.					
	Give way exiting Kimptons Road onto Twilight Road intersection.				
NO RIGHT TURN	No right turn exiting Twilight Road onto Brookby Road between the weekday hours of 7am to 9am, and 4pm to 6pm. If you are exiting Twilight Road during these times you must turn left only.				
KIMPTONS ROAD	Please be off Kimptons Road by 5:30pm, Monday to Friday and 12:00pm, Saturdays.
